How to go with the flow!

Conversion places you **in the flow.**

“Out of the same mouth come praise and cursing. My brothers, this should not be. Can both fresh water and salt water flow from the same spring?” (James 3:10-11 NIV)

Flow leads to **overflow.**

“You brood of vipers, how can you who are evil say anything good? For out of the overflow of the heart the mouth speaks.” (Matthew 12:34 NIV)

Overflow leads to **focus.**

“ . . . one thing I do: Forgetting what is behind and straining toward what is ahead, I press on toward the goal to win the prize for which God has called me heavenward in Christ Jesus.” (Philippians 3 NIV))

Focus leads to **faith.**

Faith inspires **follow-through.**

“In the same way, faith by itself, if it is not accompanied by action, is dead.” (James 2:17 NIV)

Generous wins when

You choose **honesty in business.**

"The Lord demands fairness in every business deal. He established this principle." (Prov 16:11)

You choose **trust over fear.**

"And my God will meet all your needs according to his glorious riches in Christ Jesus." (Phil 4:19 NIV)

You choose **work over worry.**

"Dishonest money dwindles away, but he who gathers money little by little makes it grow." (Prov 13:11)

You choose **tithing over tipping.**

"Will a man rob God? Surely not! And yet you have robbed me. 'What do you mean? When did we ever rob you?' You have robbed me of the tithes and offerings due to me." (Mal 3:8)

You choose **saving over debt.**
