# How to Manage Stress

#### What is stress?

## Stress is being overloaded.

"We are hard pressed on every side, but not crushed; perplexed, but not in despair; persecuted, but not abandoned; struck down, but not destroyed." (2 Cor 4:7-9 NIV).

### Stress is being overextended.

## Stress is over time.

#### What does it do?

"What do people get for all their hard work under the sun? Generations come and generations go, but the earth never changes. The sun rises and the sun sets, then hurries around to rise again. The wind blows south, and then turns north. Around and around it goes, blowing in circles. . . . Everything is wearisome beyond description. No matter how much we see, we are never satisfied. No matter how much we hear, we are not content." (Ecc 1:3-8 NLT)

## Stress will make you short-sighted.

## How to manage it:

## Daily, I will focus.

"Pay careful attention to your own work, for then you will get the satisfaction of a job well done, and you won't need to compare yourself to anyone else. For we are each responsible for our own conduct." (Gal 6:4-5 NLT)

### Weekly, I will worship.

"You have six days each week for your ordinary work, but the seventh day is a Sabbath day of rest dedicated to the Lord your God. On that day no one in your household may do any work. This includes you, your sons and daughters, your male and female servants, your livestock, and any foreigners living among you." (Exo 20:9-10)

#### Monthly, I will correct.

#### Annually, I will add and subtract.
