“Not many of you should become teachers, my fellow believers, because you know that we who teach will be judged more strictly.” (James 3:1)

As experienced guides

Teachers must be **courageous**.

“But to stop this thing from spreading any further among the people, we must warn them to speak no longer to anyone in this name.” (Acts 4:17)

Teachers must be **curious**.

Teachers must be **competent**.

“Follow God's example in everything you do just **as a much loved child imitates his father**. Be full of love for others, following the example of Christ who loved you and gave himself to God as a sacrifice to take away your sins.” (Eph 5:1-2)

Teachers must be **caring**.

Truths Pass On?

God is **Holy!**

“And they were calling to one another: ‘Holy, holy, holy is the LORD Almighty; the whole earth is full of his glory.’” (Isaiah 6:3)

God is **here!**

God has **spoken!**

People are **messy, but matter most!**
